

SENIOR MEN'S TEAM SELECTION POLICY

Objectives

To ensure that Camberwell Lacrosse Club has a transparent and equitable Senior Men's selection policy, so that all players are aware of the selection criteria and can be assured of fair and equitable treatment within the guidelines set out below.

Pre-requisites

- Players need to have paid their subs in full before their first game.
- In certain circumstances players may enter into an arrangement to pay by installments. This arrangement can only be made with the club President or Treasurer and requires an initial payment of \$100.

Selection Eligibility - Junior Players

- Junior players will be treated equally to senior players.
- All Junior players must submit a written parental permission to play in a Senior grade (irrespective of the grade). The appropriate section on the player registration form and any other permission forms must be submitted to the club before a Junior player is allowed to play in a Senior grade.

Selection Eligibility - All Players

- All players must be financial to be available for selection, priority will be given to those who have paid their subs in full.
- Players will not be eligible for selection in finals unless they have paid their subs in full for that season.
- All players will be selected on merit, this will include:
 - The needs of the team(s)
 - Attendance at training
 - Knowledge of team structures and plays
 - Ability to implement team structures and plays
 - Form
 - All things being equal, with the exception of State League, priority will be given to Senior players over Junior players.





Selection Process

- Teams will be selected each Thursday by a selection panel consisting of all Senior coaches and chaired by the State League coach (club's head coach).
- Team selections will be announced after training on each Thursday night and then posted on the club website.
